The Texas Pharmacy Foundation (TPF) is offering the Jim Martin Scholarship to a student pursuing a career in pharmacy at an accredited Texas school or college of pharmacy. The amount of the scholarship award depends on the funds available. The 2011 award will be \$1,000.

Jim Martin has been dedicated to pharmacy for nearly 35 years. Jim was the Executive Director and CEO of the Texas Pharmacy Association from 2000 - 2009. He served as Executive Director & CEO of the Texas Pharmacy Foundation from 2003 – 2009. Jim has been and still is very active in a number of local, state and national professional organizations. He has been an advocate for pharmacy throughout his career serving in the Georgia legislature for two terms and is past president of the Georgia Pharmacy Association and the National Community Pharmacist Association. While serving the Texas Pharmacy Foundation he was instrumental in developing the annual Pharmacy Leadership Conference sponsored by the Foundation. Jim and his wife, Dorinda Martin, are owners of Martin & Martin Medication Management Consultants, LLC dba as Dripping Springs Pharmacy in Dripping Springs, Texas and Lamar Plaza Drug Store in Austin, Texas.

Pharmacy students entering their fourth (P4) professional year in the fall of 2011 with a minimum GPA of 2.5 on a scale of 4.0 in required courses are eligible. In addition, the applicant must be a student member of Texas Pharmacy Association (TPA). Students will be judged on scholarship, need, and the potential to become a leader for Texas pharmacy, as demonstrated by involvement in pharmacy school and community activities.
